Detailed Itinerary

DAY 1 DEPART USA

Your safari begins today as you board your international flight to Africa.

DAYS 2 - 4 SABI SAND GAME RESERVE

Welcome to Africa! As you arrive in Johannesburg, you will be met and assisted to your flight to Notten's Bush Camp for your three-night stay.

Notten's Bush Camp is set among the acacia bushveld and open grass plains in the Sabi Sand Reserve, which adjoins Kruger National Park. As there are no fences between the private game reserves and the Park, wildlife can move unrestricted between the two areas.

Notten's Bush Camp is one of South Africa's oldest and most authentic bush camps. Owned and operated by the Notten Family for the last 15 years, Notten's is a small and intimate camp, accommodating you and 9 other people. The Camp is unique for its relaxed and informal atmosphere reminiscent of early days. Instead of electricity, paraffin lamps are used for lighting in the comfortable guest cottages, which have private en-suite bathroom facilities. In between game viewing activities, relax at the sparkling pool, read a book and take in old-fashioned Africa.

Activities: Twice daily game drives that provide excellent opportunities to experience close encounters with elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion and leopard. In addition to "The BIG 5," six other species of cat; twenty species of antelope; several dog-like species; and a variety of smaller mammals all roam the amazing Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve.

Overnight: Notten's Bush Camp (B, L, D)

DAYS 5 – 7 NGALA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, you will take a flight to Ngala Safari Lodge for your three-night stay.

The magic and mystery of Africa come alive in the colonial ambiance of elegant Ngala Safari Lodge. A timeless, unhurried atmosphere, combined with the quaint traditions of a bygone era, creates an aura of romance and nostalgia. Protected by a living canopy of immense mopane and tamboti trees, Ngala Safari Lodge carves out 20 thatched cottages with shaded verandas that ensure

the perfect privacy of your retreat. After a game viewing activity, relax by the pool or in your perfectly quaint cottage with en-suite bathroom facilities.

The Lodge is Located within the fenceless Ngala Private Game Reserve where wildlife roam between the reserve and renowned Kruger National Park. The Reserve was the first private game reserve to be incorporated into the Park. Ngala means “lion” in Shangaan and the Reserve has plenty of these beautiful cats. It also has high densities of elephant, rhino, buffalo, and African wild dogs. Giraffe, hyena, zebra and even leopards are among the other game you will encounter during your stay.

Activities: Twice daily game drives and interactive bush walks

Overnight: Ngala Safari Lodge (B, L, D)

DAYS 8 - 10 **CAPE TOWN**

This morning you will take a short flight to Mpumalanga Airport for your scheduled flight to Cape Town. You will be met at the airport and privately transferred to Four Rosmead Boutique Guesthouse for your three-night stay. Four Rosmead is an exclusive accommodation situated on the slopes of Table Mountain in the select residential suburb of Oranjezicht. Unwind after the transatlantic flight by walking through the landscaped gardens, treating yourself to a massage, or sitting on the patio overlooking the pool and herb garden. Four Rosmead is an ideal venue to use as a base to explore Cape Town and the surrounding area.

Known as the “Mother City” of South Africa, Cape Town offers much for you to enjoy over the next three incredible days. Explore on your own or take advantage of various tours (see below).

Activities: Various tours are available to see Cape Town and its main sights: Table Mountain, Lions Head, Signal Hill, Kloof Street, Table Bay and Robben Island.

DAYS 11 & 12
VICTORIA FALLS

Early this morning, you will be privately transferred to the Cape Town Airport for your flight to Victoria Falls, via Johannesburg. Upon arrival in Livingstone, you will be met and escorted to the Zambezi Sun Hotel from where you have two days to explore the area.*

The Zambezi Sun features adobe-style architecture with simple finishes highlighting bright mosaics and fabrics. The Zambezi Sun is less than a 5-minute walk from Victoria Falls and offers wildlife sightings on its grounds.

Considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Victoria Falls is known as Mosi-oa-Tunya in Zambia and means the Mist that Thunders. The falls are some of the largest in the world and will leave you awestruck by their power and beauty.

Activities: Optional activities include, Zambezi River cruise, tour national park, white water rafting, helicopter flight over the Falls, visit to local markets and villages. **We highly recommend booking any activities in advance. All activities are extra.*

Overnight: Zambezi Sun Hotel (B)

DAY 13
DEPART

After a delicious breakfast, you will be transferred to the Livingstone Airport for your flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival in Johannesburg, connect with your international flight to the United States.

Optional Botswana Extension

DAYS 13 & 14
CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

This morning your guide will collect you from your hotel for your road transfer across the border into Botswana to Kasane Airport where you are met and transferred to Muchenje Safari Lodge for your two-night stay.

Situated on the western side of the Chobe National Park, Muchenje Safari Lodge offers spectacular game viewing away from the 'crowds' of Kasane. Privately owned and managed, this intimate lodge accommodates a maximum of 20 guests in comfortable chalets overlooking the Chobe floodplains. Each chalet has its own en-suite facilities with a shower and electricity. Muchenje Safari Lodge provides the most tranquil and hospitable atmosphere of all the Chobe Lodges. Watch the wildlife graze along the Chobe River while relaxing by the pool.

Chobe National Park encompasses 11,700 km² of wilderness, bordered in the north by the beautiful Chobe River, and buffered on all sides by wildlife management areas and forest reserves, allowing for the free movement of game. A wildlife enthusiast's dream, Chobe National Park is one of the top wilderness reserves in the world and is home to the largest single concentration of elephant. Two species of region-specific antelope occur here, the puku and the Chobe bushbuck, which cannot be seen in other parts of Botswana except on the Chobe riverfront.

Activities: Twice daily game viewing activities in 4x4 vehicles, boat cruises along the Chobe River, cultural visits to local villages

Overnight: Chobe Muchenje Safari Lodge (B, L, D)

**DAY 15
DEPART**

After a morning game viewing activity and breakfast, you will be transferred to the Kasane Airport for your flight to Livingstone and onto Johannesburg. Upon arrival in Johannesburg, connect with your international flight to the United States.
