Detailed Itinerary

DAY 1 DEPART USA

Your safari begins today as you board your international flight to Africa.

DAYS 2-4 CAPE TOWN

Welcome to Africa! You will be met at the Cape Town airport and privately transferred to The Commodore Hotel for your three-night stay. Located at the highest point on the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront, The Commodore commands amazing views of all of Cape Town's main sites. Your luxury accommodation offers all of the amenities you would expect from a 5-star hotel, including a well-equipped gym, pool area with sauna, steam room, and access to personal trainers. The on-site restaurants offer fine dining in a relaxed setting or you can venture out to the many restaurants and coffee shops located on the Waterfront, just steps from the hotel.

Known as the "Mother City" of South Africa, Cape Town offers much for you to enjoy over the next three incredible days. Explore on your own or take advantage of one of many optional tours.

Activities: Various tours are available to see Cape Town and its main sights: Table Mountain, Lions Head, Signal Hill, Kloof Street, Table Bay and Robben Island.

DAYS 5 & 6 GARDEN ROUTE

After breakfast, you will be collected from The Commodore Hotel and chauffeured along the spectacular Garden Route, a beautiful stretch of coastline from Heidelberg to the Tsitsikamma Forest and Storms River. You will stay at the beautiful Protea Hotel Knysna Quays for two nights. One of the best hotel locations in South Africa, the Protea Hotel is set on the Knysna Quays Waterfront with the lagoon at your doorstep. Nestled in the heart of the Garden Route, the hotel has a wide array of choice facilities, including a heated outdoor swimming pool, a therapist for rejuvenating massages and aromatherapy treatments, and six unique restaurants to choose from.

Activities: Visit charming towns, hike, get up close with cheetahs, interact with baby elephants at a sanctuary, ride an ostrich, or take a boat ride on the incredible Knysna Lagoon.

DAYS 7-10
MADIKWE PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Today you will fly to Johannesburg where you will connect with a flight to Madikwe Private Game Reserve where you will then be met and transferred to the Madikwe Safari Lodge for your four-night family safari.

Madikwe Safari Lodge is situated in the heart of the richly diverse and malaria-free 76,000-hectare (187,800 acre) Madikwe Game Reserve. One of South Africa's biggest wildlife sanctuaries. Madikwe's diverse geology and broad mix of habitats allows a wide range of wildlife to flourish, including The Big Five (elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion, and leopard), cheetah and a thriving population of wild dog. Madikwe is a triumph for private conservation and was home to history's largest game translocation. It is also actively involved in community development including special programs for skills upliftment and positive health wellness programs. Madikwe Safari Lodge works closely with the North-West Parks Board assisting in wildlife monitoring and research.

Set on a gentle slope nestled between two rolling hills, Madikwe Safari Lodge overlooks game-filled plains with the Dwarsberg Hills in the distance and the Marico River nearby. The Lodge offers exceptional game-viewing, simple yet sophisticated accommodation, superlative service and unique regional cuisine. Each family suite features a sitting area, a bedroom with circular fireplace, an en-suite bathroom with bath, indoor and outdoor shower, and a private plunge pool. Intimate sitting areas have shaded outdoor seating on expansive covered decks. There are plentiful fireplaces both inside and outdoors, pizza ovens for fun dining and book-filled libraries. Early dinners, videos and coloring books are available for children and shortened game drives can be arranged depending on vehicle and ranger availability.

Activities: Twice daily game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles and interactive bush walks

Overnight: Madikwe Safari Lodge (B, L, D & beverages; laundry)

DAY 11
DEPART

After an early morning game drive, you will take a flight from the game reserve to Madikwe Private Game Reserve to Johannesburg to connect to your international flight back to the United States.
