Detailed Itinerary

DAY 1 DEPART USA

Your safari begins today as you board your international flight to Africa.

DAYS 2 - 4 CAPE TOWN

Welcome to Africa! You will be met at the airport and privately transferred to Four Rosmead Boutique Guesthouse. Built in 1903, Four Rosmead is an exclusive accommodation situated on the slopes of Table Mountain in the select residential suburb of Oranjezicht. Unwind after the transatlantic flight by walking through the landscaped gardens, treating yourself to a massage, or sitting on the patio overlooking the pool and herb garden. Four Rosmead is an ideal venue to use as a base to explore Cape Town and the surrounding area.

Known as the “Mother City” of South Africa, Cape Town offers much for you to enjoy over the next three incredible days. Explore on your own or take advantage of one of many optional tours.

Activities: Various tours are available to see Cape Town and its main sights: Table Mountain, Lions Head, Signal Hill, Kloof Street, Table Bay and Robben Island.

DAYS 5 & 6
SABI SAND PRIVATE RESERVE

After breakfast, take the complimentary hotel shuttle bus back to the airport where you board your flight to Mala Mala Airport in Kruger National Park. On arrival, you will be met and transferred by road to Notten's Bush Camp for a two-night stay.

Notten's Bush Camp is set among the acacia bushveld and open grass plains in the Sabi Sand Reserve, which adjoins Kruger National Park. As there are no fences between the private game reserve and the Park, wildlife move unrestricted between the two areas.

Notten's Bush Camp is one of South Africa's oldest and most authentic bush camps. Owned and operated by the Notten Family for the last 15 years, Notten's is a small and intimate camp, accommodating you and 9 other people. The Camp is unique for its relaxed and informal atmosphere reminiscent of early days. Instead of electricity, paraffin lamps are used for lighting in the comfortable guest cottages, which have private en-suite bathroom facilities. In between game viewing activities, relax at the sparkling pool, read a book and take in old-fashioned Africa.

Activities: Twice daily game drives that provide excellent opportunities to experience close encounters with elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion and leopard. In addition to "The BIG 5," six other species of cat; twenty species of antelope; several dog-like species; and a variety of smaller mammals all roam the amazing Sabi Sand Private Game Reserve.

DAY 7
JOHANNESBURG

Upon arrival of your flight to Johannesburg, make your way to the hotel shuttle area where you will board the complimentary hotel shuttle to the Peermont Mondior Hotel for one night.

Contemporary convenience at its best, the Peermont Mondior offers stylish and comfortable rooms which include LCD flat screen TV, satellite DSTV channels for all languages, tea and coffee stations, secure internet connections, and more. Emperors Palace is a casino and convention resort conveniently situated alongside OR Tambo International Airport.

DAYS 8 & 9 VICTORIA FALLS

You will make your way back to the Johannesburg Airport via the complimentary shuttle and check in for your flight to Livingstone, Zambia. Upon arrival in Livingstone, you will be met and escorted to the Zambezi Sun Hotel from where you have two days to explore the area.*

The Zambezi Sun features adobe-style architecture with simple finishes highlighting bright mosaics and fabrics. The Zambezi Sun is less than a 5-minute walk from Victoria Falls and offers wildlife sightings on its grounds. Considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Victoria Falls is known as Mosi-oa-Tunya in Zambia and means the Mist that Thunders. The falls are some of the largest in the world and will leave you awestruck by their power and beauty.

Activities: Optional activities include, Zambezi River cruise, tour national park, white water rafting, helicopter flight over the Falls, visit to local markets and villages. **We highly recommend booking any activities in advance. All activities are extra.*

Overnight: Zambezi Sun Hotel (B)

DAYS 10 & 11 CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Today, you will be collected at your hotel and transferred to the Livingstone airport for your flight to Kasane airport in Botswana, where you will then board your flight to Chobe Under Canvas for two nights.

Featuring just six superlative ensuite safari tents, the elegant and luxurious Chobe Under Canvas is situated in the northern part of Chobe National Park near the Chobe River. The guest areas are comprised of comfortable tents for dining, relaxing with new friends, or taking time for yourself between safaris. Private butler service, delicious pan-African meals, and traditional bush dinners served under the stars complete your stay. ** There is no running water in your tent.*

Chobe National Park encompasses 11,700 km² of wilderness, bordered in the north by the beautiful Chobe River, and buffered on all sides by wildlife management areas and forest reserves, allowing for the free movement of game. A wildlife enthusiast's dream, Chobe National Park is one of the top wilderness reserves in the world and is home to the largest single concentration of elephant. Two species of region-specific antelope occur here, the puku and the Chobe bushbuck, which cannot be seen in other parts of Botswana except on the Chobe riverfront.

Activities: Twice-daily game drives in semi-open 4x4 safari vehicles and a tranquil boat cruise on the Chobe River

Overnight: Chobe Under Canvas (B, L, D, & all beverages)

DAYS 12 & 13

OKAVANGO DELTA

Today you will fly to Nxabega Okavango Camp for your two-night stay.

Nxabega Okavango Safari Camp is situated in Botswana's Okavango Delta. Nxabega is on the edge of the Delta in a 7000-hectare exclusive wildlife concession. The Camp houses a maximum of 18 guests and nestles under a dense stand of African Ebony and Strangler Fig trees. Ten safari tents stand on raised wooden platforms with private verandahs where game can be viewed all year round. Lion and hyena are routinely seen in camp at night and the birding is exceptional.

Botswana's magnificent Okavango Delta is a maze of lagoons, lakes and hidden channels covering an area of over 16,000 square km in flood and shrinking to less than 9,000 square km in the dry season. Trapped in the parched Kalahari sands, this fresh water oasis attracts wildlife that depends on the permanent waters. Sable, giraffe, zebra, buffalo, lion, and elephant, drift through the Kalahari woodlands. This Delta is one of the planet's most extraordinary wild places and Botswana's most valuable natural resource.

Activities: Twice daily game drives, guided bush walks through the Delta, and boating through the waterways via mokoro (dugout canoe)

Overnight: Nxabega Okavango Safari Camp (B, L, D, & all beverages; laundry)

DAYS 14 & 15

MOREMI GAME RESERVE

After a morning game drive, you will take a flight to Sandibe Safari Lodge for your two-night stay.

Sandibe Safari Lodge is also located in the incredible Okavango Delta on the border of the Moremi Game Reserve. The lodge sleeps a maximum of 16 guests in eight intimate African-inspired cottages, each of which has an en-suite bathroom, open air shower, and private verandahs. The main area has a lounge, dining room, an elevated library and a viewing deck. There is also an outdoor dining area under large trees where meals can be served, weather permitting, and a plunge pool to provide relief from the midday heat.

Activities: Twice daily game drives, guided bush walks through the Delta, and boating through the waterways via mokoro

Overnight: Sandibe Safari Lodge (B, L, D & all beverages; laundry)

**DAY 16
DEPART**

After a morning game viewing activity, take a short flight to Maun to connect to your flights to Johannesburg and onto the United States.
