ZITOUNI

Traditional Egyptian fare is served at one of Four Seasons Cairo's numerous restaurants, with a variety of mezze and starters. The restaurant overlooks the Nile and serves outstanding authentic dishes. The elegant interior offers wonderful views and is suitable for couples and families.

8 is a world-class Cantonese restaurant with classical Chinese flair. Dumplings, seafoods, soups and delicious braised duck. Hand-thrown noodles, delicately prepared spring rolls and each meal prepared and presented impeccably add to the authenticity of the cuisine.

REVOLVING RESTAURANT

On the 41st floor of the Grand Nile Tower, the restaurant offers ever-changing views of the cityscape. A show kitchen at the restaurant's center prepares world-class French cuisine. Open for dinner only, with formal dress required and no alcohol is served.

139 LOUNGE

With possibly the best view of any Cairo eatery, 139 Lounge is the Marriott's bistro-style restaurant. Serving international cuisine, from Italian to Indian, Mexican and familiar western dishes, this is a casual dining restaurant with absolutely priceless views (above).

FOUR SEASONS EXPERIENTIAL DINING

In addition to its four in-house restaurants, Four Seasons offer two further dining experiences. Though static, First Nile Boat brings dining onto the Nile. Guests can choose from Brazilian, Asian (incorporating Japanese, Cantonese, Indian and Thai), Greek or an open-air pizzeria.

The second experience, for residents only, is unlike any other. A private tent will be prepared on the Giza plateau overlooking the pyramids, illuminated as the night falls. A private chef will cater to your epicurean desires while traditional music is played, the spectacular evening concluding with a traditional tanoura show.
